Tree Removal

1. COMPLETED APPLICATION
2. PROOF OF PROPERTY OWNERSHIP; PROPERTY RECORD CARD
3. SURVEY - LOCATION OF TREE(S) TO BE REMOVED AND ALL REMAINING TREES ON THE PROPERTY.
4. COPY OF ANY ARC, ARB, OR HOA APPROVAL IF APPLICABLE.
5. OWNER BUILDER AFFIDAVIT IF WORK IS CONDUCTED BY THE OWNER.
6. ARBORIST LETTER IF APPLICABLE.

What is a canopy tree?

Any tree indigenous to the state of Florida that grows to a minimum height of forty (40) feet and provides a thirty-foot radius of shade at full maturation. Canopy trees are known for their height and broad canopies. They provide shade.

What is an understory tree?

Any indigenous tree to the state of Florida that is not a canopy tree but grows to a minimum height of fifteen (15) feet. Understory trees are smaller than canopy trees. They can survive below a canopy tree; they are shade tolerant.

Section 6.5. - Single-Family Residential Lots. Landscaping

Each single-family lot will be required to have one (1) canopy tree with a DBH at planting of at least three (3) inches and two (2) understory trees each with a DBH at planting of at least two (2) inches. One (1) of the trees on each single-family lot shall be planted in the front yard, no less than five (5) feet and no more than eight (8) feet from the sidewalk.
