


STUDENTS RIDE FREE

Catch a LakeXpress bus to class

LakeXpress operates Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. - 8 p.m. along five routes.

- **Route 1** runs from The Villages to Eustis, primarily on U.S. Highway 441.
- **Route 2** circulates in downtown Leesburg.
- **Route 3** circulates in downtown Mount Dora.
- **Route 4** runs from the Altoona Post Office on State Road 19 to Zellwood on U.S. Highway 441 where passengers can transfer to LYNX Route 44.
- **Route 50** provides service between Mascotte and the Winter Garden Regional Shopping Center in Orange County. The route will make fixed stops along State Road 50 to the Orange County line, where passengers may transfer to LYNX Link 105 to Orlando. The bus will also make stops at the Mascotte City Hall, South Lake Hospital and the South Lake Campus of Lake-Sumter State College.



LakeXpress, Lake County's fixed-route bus service, provides public transportation in two areas of the county. In the northern portion of the county, services are provided along the U.S. Highway 441 corridor, including the municipalities of Eustis, Fruitland Park, Lady Lake, Leesburg, Mount Dora, Tavares and Umatilla. Service also connects to Orange County via LYNX in Zellwood. Additionally, fixed-route service is provided in South Lake County along State Road 50 with connection to Orange County via LYNX Link 105 in Winter Garden.

LakeXpress Route 50 operates Monday - Friday, 5 a.m. to 8 p.m., and provides service between Mascotte and the Winter Garden Regional Shopping Center in Orange County with connections to LYNX Link 105 to Orlando.

LYNX Information - Transferring to and from LakeXpress Route 4 to LYNX Link 44 and LakeXpress Route 50 to LYNX Link 105, is free with a valid transfer pass.

*Transfers may only be used to complete a one way trip.

1. Half fares are available for:
 - Seniors aged 60 years or older
 - Medicare cardholders
 - Persons who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI), based on disability, or Social Security Disability (SSD) benefits
 - Veterans with an ID card
 - Disabled persons (buses are ADA accessible)
2. Children under 5 years of age that are accompanied by a fare-paying chaperone ride for free.
3. Students with a school issued photo ID or a Lake County issued student pass ride free.

To purchase a bus pass, call 352-326-8637 or log on to www.ridelakexpress.com. Bus passes may also be purchased from the Lake County Transit Division and the libraries in Fruitland Park, Lady Lake and Leesburg, and at Tavares City Hall.

All purchases are final and non-refundable. Passes cannot be transferred. Copying or other reproduction of LakeXpress passes is prohibited. A valid identification is required for all discounted fares. Drivers will punch the pass at the time of first use. Date punched reflects expiration date. Exact change is required for all fares.

Bus Stops

Passengers may board and exit the bus at designated LakeXpress bus stop locations along the route. Passengers may depart the bus by using the pull cord or notifying the driver of their desired drop-off location. The driver will determine the most safe and convenient location to allow passengers to board or exit the bus.

Americans with Disabilities (ADA) Complementary Paratransit Services are available for those who meet the eligibility requirements of the program. For more information contact Lake County Transit Division at 352-326-8637.

Lake County Connection - This door-to-door service is primarily intended for mobility-impaired, mentally impaired, senior citizens and other individuals who are transportation disadvantaged and that meet the eligibility requirements. The service is provided for individuals who do not have access to any other means of transportation, including public bus service. LYNX - Connection services to Orange County are provided by Link 105 to downtown Orlando, and Link 55 in the Four Corners community, which travels along U.S. Highway 192. For more information, call 407-841-LYNX (5969) or log on to www.golynx.com.

On The Bus

- Use exact fare or a pass. Drivers do not carry change.
- Standing is permitted behind the white line only. When standing, hold on to the handrail or seat handle while the bus is in motion.
- No eating, drinking, smoking or littering allowed on the buses.
- Please keep all bus stop areas free from litter.
- All passengers must wear shirts and shoes.
- Priority seating in the front section of the buses is reserved for disabled persons and elderly riders. Flip-type seats located near the wheelchair boarding entrance are for people using wheelchairs.
- Please talk quietly in your seats and while using cell phones; no running or playing on the buses.
- No soliciting, disruptive behavior, fighting or vandalism.
- While on the bus, it is prohibited to play radios or other sound devices without earphones.
- Service animals are allowed for riders with disabilities. There is no added fare.
